We are working to develop healthy activities to help Washougal to recreate in a safe and healthy environment once state officials find it safe for activities.

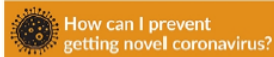
THINGS WILL GET BETTER

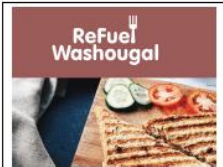
